What to See if You Have Limited Time



1 HOUR

If you have one hour . . . find one or two exhibits that are close to each other like the Herpetarium and Island Life. Or explore Cat Forest/Lion Overlook where adventurers can get eye to eye with a pride of African lions.

2 HOURS

If you have 2 hours . . . pick an area of the Zoo and discover its animal residents. Venture into the south Hoofstock area, experience the fun of the meerkats and marvel at the spectrum of colors in the aquariums at Aquaticus.

3 HOURS

If you have 3 hours or more . . . why not make a day of it? Purchase a *Safari Tram* ticket and enjoy a narrated tour of the south portion of the campus. Take a spin on the *Endangered Species Carousel* located next to the playground along Zoo Lake.
